SUMMER LAWN CARE The Trustees are looking for someone to mow our church lawns this summer. Please contact the church office if you are interested or know of someone who would be interested.

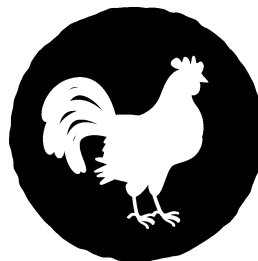

5th Sunday in Lent

Genesis 22:2 – “He said, ‘Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.’ ” It’s hard for us to even fathom a faith as strong as Abraham’s: he follows the Lord’s Word even when it seems impossibly hard. But he does so because he knows that the Lord only means to bless. What happened here to Abraham should be an encouragement for us: trust the Lord and keep His Word.

(As a prayer of preparation use one of today’s hymns the prayers inside the front cover of the hymnal.)

WELCOME GUESTS. Before His death and resurrection Jesus is hailed as King and celebrated. He entered humble and meek and today rides into our lives in humble means of bread and wine that is His body and blood. It can never be understated what it means that God is with us in flesh and blood for our forgiveness! In honor of God's Word we practice close communion, we ask that guests and visitors speak with the Pastor before communing.
