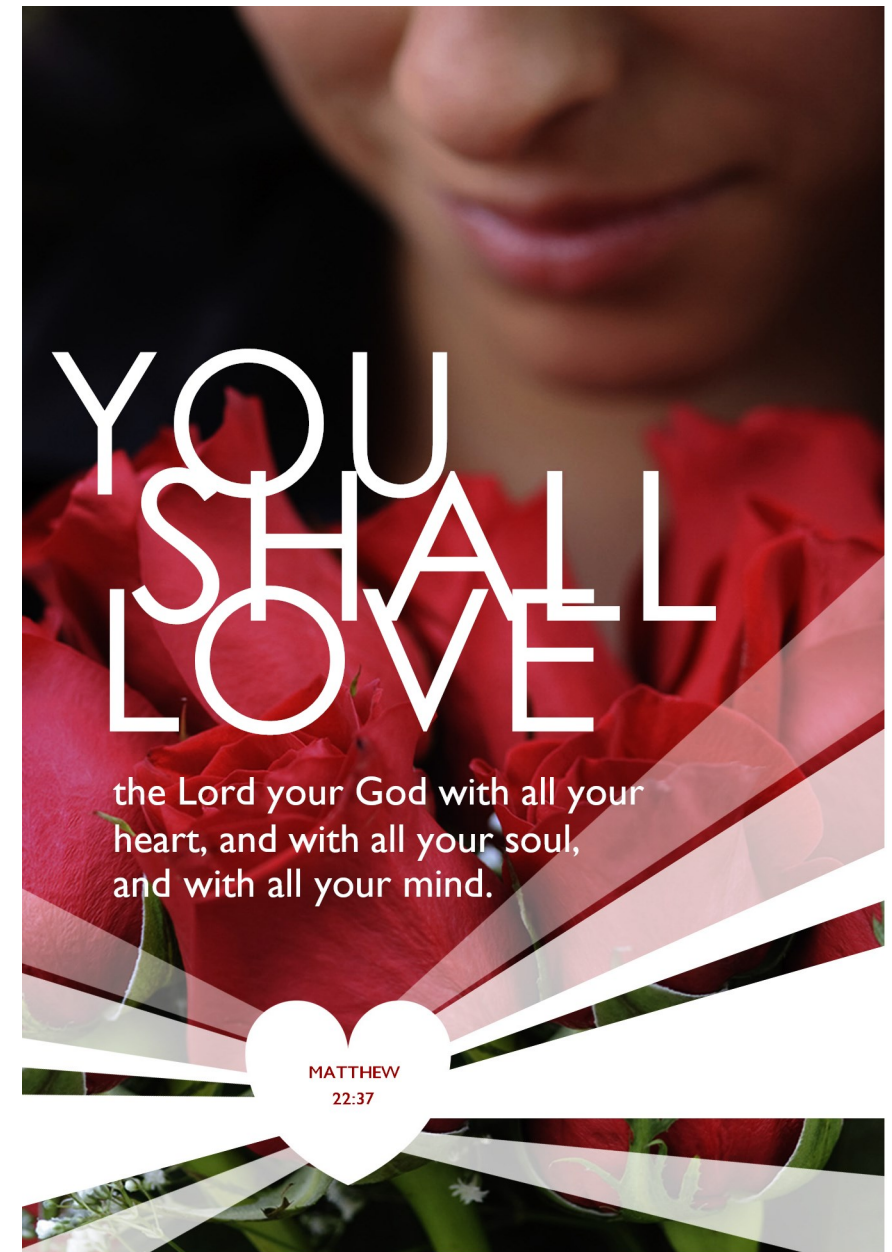

**Eighteenth Sunday after Trinity**

**"I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus."** The grace of God and thanksgiving go together. God has given us everything we possess and everything that we are. He is the Giver. Once we realize this, then thankfulness wells up inside of us. How could it not? As Paul shows us here, it's not only the grace given to us individually that causes us to give thanks but even the grace given to others. We certainly have much to be thankful for when we look at the gifts of grace all around us. And how do we say thank you to the Lord?

**WELCOME GUESTS.** The Lord's Supper is an intrusion into our lives! Jesus enters today into our lives with His presence in flesh and blood for our forgiveness. As we celebrate this Sacrament, we humbly acknowledge the Scriptural concern for doctrinal oneness by those who receive it together. For that reason, we ask guests who desire to commune to please speak with pastor before the service.

**BIBLE STUDY** Apparently a significant figure in Israel or Judah had died, thus prompting a number of dignitaries from both nations to come together at Bethel for a social gathering. Amos 6:4-6 calls the people to task for their pampered prosperity and boisterous banquets, for greed and arrogant security, and a life of *carpe diem*. Because this kind of self-indulgence and self-confidence are rampant, Amos announces that "the first ones" in luxury (Amos 6:1, 6) will be the "first ones" to go into exile (6:7). Unbeknownst to the revelers, their banquet is preparing them for the grave.
