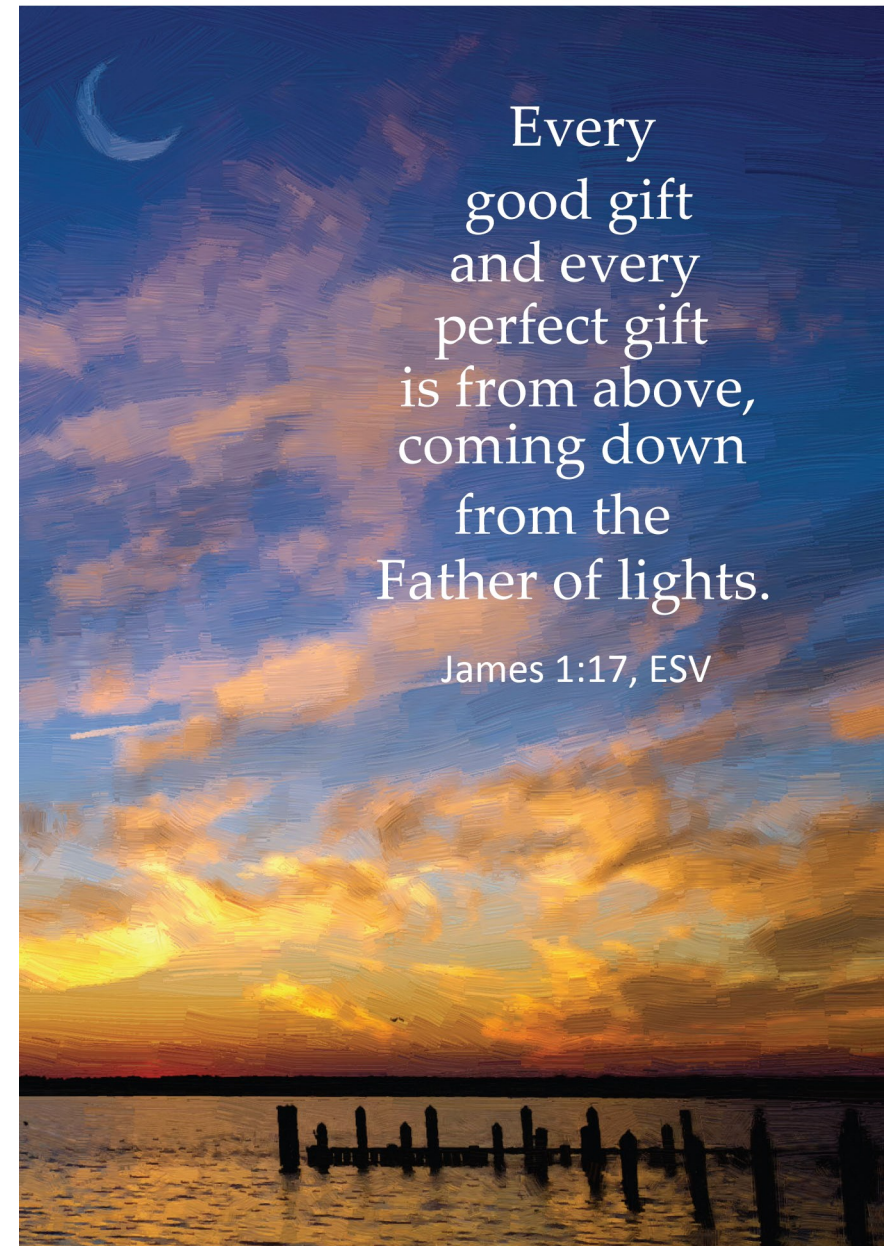

## First Sunday in Lent

**Mark 1:13** – “And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him.” God the Father cares for Jesus even in the midst of his temptation in the wilds. God cares for us in every situation as well. Jesus realized this and always acted from the basis of trust in God the Father's provision. This is likewise the basis for our life lived in Christ: God cares for us, so we need not act out of fear or greed.

**LENT 2021.** Join us this Lent season as we “Follow Jesus” The Wednesday services will begin at 6:00 pm, no supper beforehand is being planned at this time. This weeks theme is “Follow the Tree” from 1 Peter 2:24.

**NURSERY/CHAPEL** (unattended): Here at St. Peter's we believe it is important for all to be present to hear God's Word, but that at times there is a need to step out. There is a small chapel room to the front left (lectern side) that allows the look and feel of church.

**THE CALL COMMITTEE** has been meeting regularly since Pastor Amen accepted his call in November. We have adhered to the call process laid out for us and through deliberation and prayer, we have narrowed down the list of candidates. We anticipate to begin the interview process within the next several weeks. We appreciate your continued patience, prayers and reflection during this time, as we navigate through this journey of calling our new Pastor.

**SYNOD CONVENTION QUESTION:** *Shall the Synod add a year to the current 2019–2022 triennium, allowing districts to hold their conventions in either 2021 or 2022, and moving the upcoming national Synod convention from 2022 to 2023?* More than the required one-fourth (63.32%) of the Synod's member congregations registered a vote, and the majority (90.67%) of votes cast favored adoption. The stated extension of the 2019–2022 triennium by a year, allowing district conventions to take place in either 2021 or 2022 and deferring the national Synod convention from 2022 to 2023, is therefore adopted. Consequently the LCMS National Synod Convention has been delayed for one year to be held in 2023.
