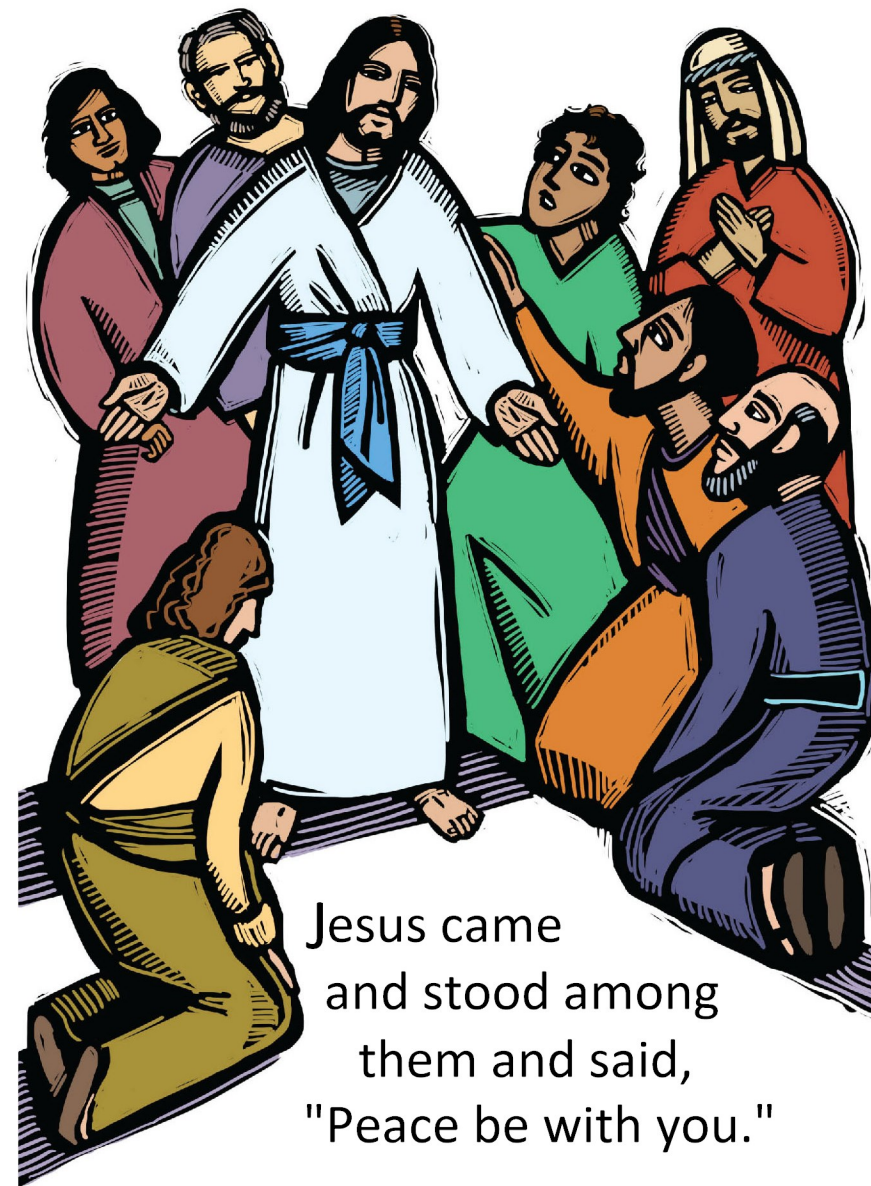

2nd Sunday of Easter

John 20:19 – “Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, ‘Peace be with you.’ ” The peace we have in Jesus is what makes a life of good works possible. Since we know that it is Jesus who saved us – not our works – we are now free to do good works. Good works shouldn’t be done out of self-interest but for the right reasons – out of thanksgiving toward God and love for our neighbors.

(As a prayer of preparation use one of today's hymns or the prayers inside the front cover of the hymnal.)

WELCOME GUESTS The Lord’s Supper is a continuation of the resurrection appearance of the risen Christ. It is much the same as Jesus saying, “Put your fingers here, see My hands. Stop doubting and believe.” As Jesus promised, we believe that He is present in body and blood in this Sacrament. We also believe in that the oneness of doctrine is necessary for those who receive this Sacrament together. We therefore ask guests to speak with the pastor before communing.
