With such confidence we are liberated from worry and freed to do good with our material resources, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

WELCOME GUESTS The Lord's Supper is joyfully received here today. At the altar, our Lord Jesus Christ delivers His True Body and Blood into our mouths. His Body and Blood forgives our sins, strengthens our faith, binds us to the Lord, and unites us with each other. In this is life and salvation. All members of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod have publicly confessed this sacred gift and its blessings, and so are encouraged to commune. Other guests wishing to join our confession and receive this Holy Sacrament are asked to meet with Pastor Juhl in the weeks before communing for the first time. Those coming to the altar for a blessing rather than the Holy Supper are asked to cross their arms over their chest.
