The Day of Pentecost

Man's self-exaltation causes a confusion of language. In his desire to make a name for himself, he brings the judgment of being divided and scattered. However, by the coming of the Holy Spirit, mankind is brought together and united in Christ. Language barriers are broken down as the people hear the wonderful works of God in their own native tongue. Through the preaching of the cross, the Holy Spirit draws people from all nations into the one, holy, Christian, apostolic church. The Holy Spirit teaches and brings to our remembrance the words of Jesus, which are the words of the Father who sent Him. These words bestow forgiveness and peace to those who keep and hold on to them in love for Jesus. For He said, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

WELCOME GUESTS Jesus promised that it was to our advantage that He ascend and send the Holy Spirit (John 16:7). On Pentecost as the Holy Spirit empowered the preaching of repentance and the forgiveness of sins, leading to many baptisms and the reception of the Lord's Supper (Acts 2). The Holy Spirit is still at work today, revealing to us the true body and blood of Christ present in the Sacrament.
