**LENT SERVICE PROJECT:** Again this year for Lent, we as a congregation, will be collecting items for Lutheran World Relief and their Personal Care Kits. We will have an item each week, and of course you may bring items in anytime. Our goal is 200 kits this year as these are in high demand due to compounding crises around the globe, such as war, violence, natural disasters, disease, and extreme weather.

- *March 12: Bars of Soap (2 per kit, 4-5 oz. each in original wrapping)*
- *March 19: Bath Towel, no bigger than 27"x 52" (lightweight, darker colors recommended)*
- *March 26: Hair comb or toothbrushes (adult size, in original packaging)*
- *April 2: Bath Towel, no bigger than 27"x 52" (yes, again, these are the limiting factor, many are needed)*
- *April 9: Nail clippers (metal, attached file optional)*

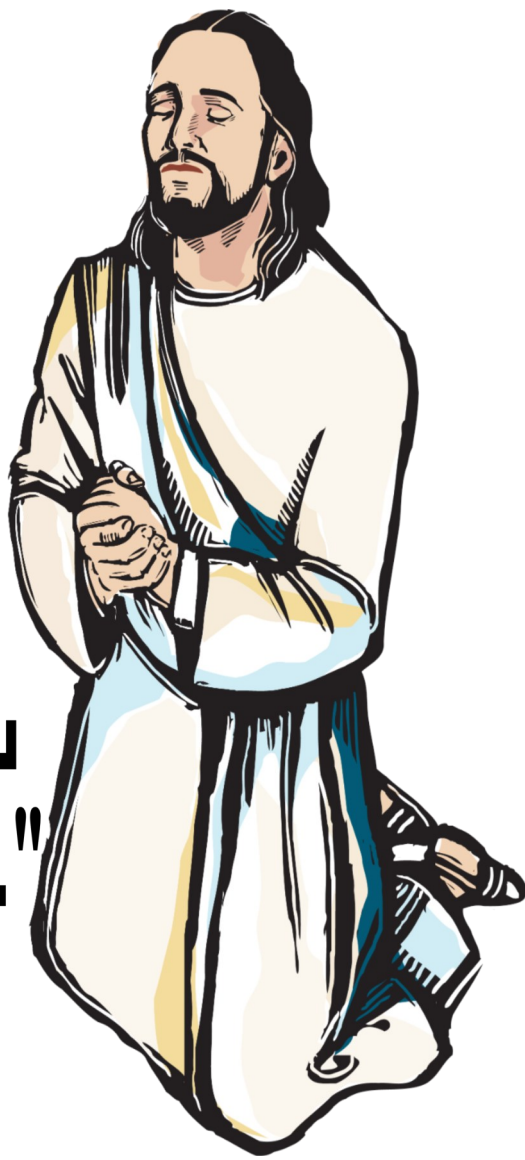

**First Sunday in Lent**

In the Garden man exalts himself to be a god in place of God. He succumbs to the temptation of the devil, and eating of the forbidden fruit he receives death. But in the sin-cursed wilderness God humbles Himself to become man in place of man. He does not eat but fasts and bears the onslaughts of the devil for us that we may be restored to life. Jesus stands as David in our place to do battle against the Goliath Satan. Though outwardly Jesus appears weak, yet He comes in the name of the Lord of hosts. He draws from the five smooth stones of the books of Moses and slings the Word of God. The stone sinks into the forehead, and the enemy falls. In Christ we are victorious over the devil.
