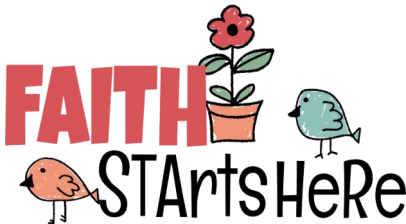

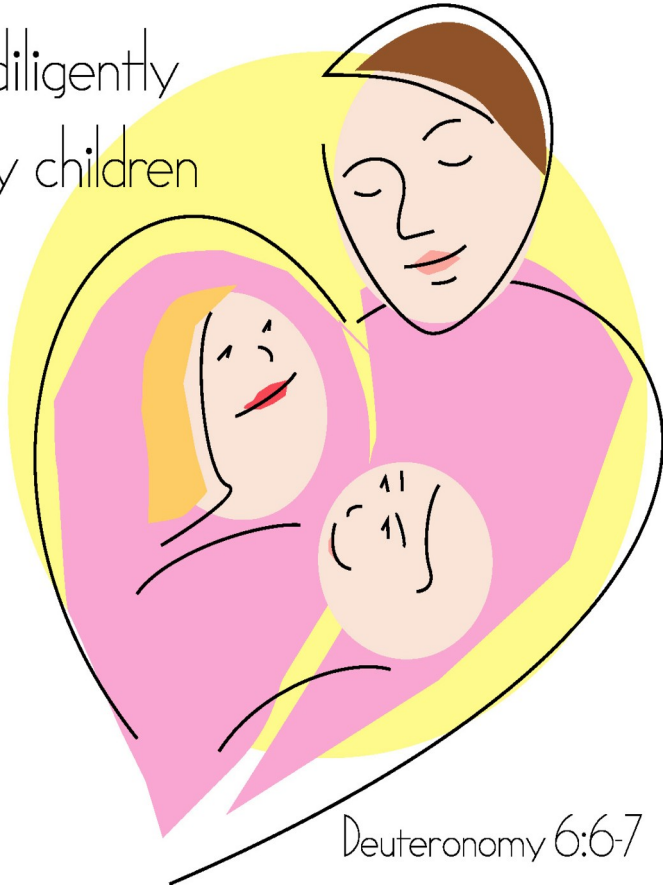

“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.” Moses commanded the Israelites to teach these words to their children. How are children to know their Lord unless they are taught? Parents taught their children the Lord’s promise to love them in sending Messiah, Jesus Christ, to save them from their sins. Messiah has come, and Saint Peter tells the crowds on the Day of Pentecost, “The promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself.” Gentiles are included in the promise of salvation first meant for the Jews. As Messiah Himself said, “Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it.” Let us become like children again and receive the Good News with joyful hearts, ever learning Jesus is Lord.
